Introduction

The Department of Banking and Finance of the Wayamba University of Sri Lanka announces its Diploma in Banking and Financial Studies (DBFS) Programme for the year 2021. This programme is intended to fulfill future demand of the financial sector by providing equipped human capital requirements. The DBFS programme prepares prospective candidates for a career in financial sector and services. The programme facilitate learning in theory and practices of major disciplines in economics, banking and finance and to equip the students with an integrate approach to managerial skills.

The course units are designed in such a manner to develop analytical, problem solving and decision making abilities, awareness of domestic and international economics and financial environment. The course structure comprised with compulsory ten course units and upon successful completion of Diploma allows candidates to develop a learning programme that reflects their personal circumstances or career aspirations.

Programme Objectives

- ◆ The main objective of the programme is to improve the knowledge, skills and attitudes of banking staff and those who would planning to join banking industry as junior and senior executives
- ◆ To provide participants with an opportunity to develop knowledge of core concepts and theories in economics and banking and sharpen decision making capabilities
- ◆ Provide an opportunity to improve and update the knowledge in the fields of banking
- ◆ To improve research capabilities and create research opportunities in economics and banking
- ◆ To give an opportunity to organizations to train their own employees in a university background

Target Group

- ◆ The DBFS has been designed to school leavers those who wish to join to the financial sector
- ◆ Those who are awaiting to embark into Higher Diploma in Banking and Finance
- ◆ Anyone who wish to hold a recognized respected banking and finance qualification for their career aspirations.

Program Structure

The programme of study comprises

a. Nine taught course Modules

Economic Theory, Quantitative Methods for Banking & Finance, Money, Banking and Financial Services, Entrepreneurship and Financing, Introduction to Banking Law, Managerial Economics, Financial Institutions & Markets, Project Evaluation and Risk Analysis, International Business and Finance

b. Comprehensive Project Module

This module envisaged to demonstrate the candidate's ability to apply his /her learning in an empirical context. This takes the form of critical essay of 7500 words. This course module incorporates training in academic research and writing

Programme Duration

The Diploma in Banking and Financial Studies (DBFS) is organized on a semester system over a period of one (01) academic year, and the examinations shall be held at end of first and second semester-ends. The number of credits to be offered is 30 credits, covered entirely 450 lecture hours (SLQF 3).

Admission Requirements

- Passed in G.C.E (A/L) examination in any stream in a single attempt, OR
 - Six passes in G.C.E (O/L) Examination in one sitting with three credits with two years working experience in a reputed institution after obtaining the qualification, OR
 - Any other qualification not listed above with two years working experience, but may be considered case by case and acceptable to the Board of Study and the Senate of WUSL.
- And
- A good knowledge of English
 - Perform well at the admission test and or the interview

Method of Delivery

Lecture sessions will be conducted online. However, seminars, workshops, practical sessions and examinations will be conducted in the University
