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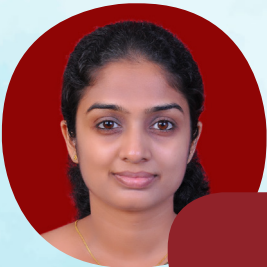
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Message from the Vice-Chancellor

Education system within Covid 19: Combating with Resilience



The COVID-19 pandemic has created the largest disruption to the education systems thought the world. The crisis is worsening, preexisting education disparities by reducing the opportunities for many of the most helpless children, youth, and the adults as well. Similarly, the education disruption has had, and will continue to have substantial effects beyond education. Closures of the educational institutions hamper the provision of essential services to the children and communities. As fiscal pressures increase, and development assistance comes under tension, the financing of education could also face major challenges, worsening massive pre-COVID-19 education funding gaps. On the other hand, this crisis has stimulated innovation within the education sector. We have seen innovative approaches in the support of education and training continuity: from radio and television to take-home packages. Distance learning solutions were developed thanks to the quick responses by the governments and partners all over the world supporting the continuity of education. But however, we have observed that, in Sri Lanka, majority of students are facing many difficulties due to the unavailability of the required resources in relation to distance learning solutions. On the other hand, mostly, the majority of the poor and uneducated parents are frustrated and still facing a number of difficulties towards the arena of online teaching and learning environment. We have also been reminded of the essential roles of the teachers and the governments and the other key partners to have an ongoing duty of care to education personnel. But, these changes have also highlighted that the promising future of learning, and the accelerated changes in modes of delivering quality education, cannot be separated from the imperative of leaving no one behind. This is true for children and the youth affected

by the lack of resources or enabling environments to access learning. It is true for the teaching profession and their need for a better training in the new methods of education delivery, as well as support. And also, it is true that the negative idea of the educational specialists towards distance learning solutions especially in relation to the behavioral sciences and technical education, they expect physical touch. At large, including local communities, upon whom the education continuity depends during crisis and who are key to building back better.

The COVID-19 crisis and the unparalleled education disruption are far from over. As many countries have yet to announce a date for the educational institutions to reopen and across the world, the governments, unions, parents and children are grappling with when and how to approach the next phase. Countries have started planning to reopen the educational institutions nationwide, either based on grade levels and by prioritizing exam classes, or through localized openings in regions with fewer cases of the virus. However, given the continued virulence of the virus, Sri Lanka has yet to decide on a reopening date. These decisions carry enormous social and economic implications and will have lasting effects on educators, children and youth, on their parents and indeed on societies as a whole.

Recommendations

Preventing a learning crisis from becoming a generational catastrophe requires urgent action from all. Education is not only a fundamental human right but also an enabling right with direct impact on the realization of all other human rights. It is a global common good and a primary driver of progress across the sustainable development goals as a bedrock of just, equal, inclusive peaceful societies. When education systems collapse, peaceful, prosperous and productive societies cannot be sustained. In order to mitigate the potentially devastating consequences of the COVID-19 pandemic, the governments and stakeholders are encouraged to pursue the following policy responses: plan for the re-openings of the educational institutions: The single most significant step that countries can take to accelerate the reopening of the education institutions is to suppress transmission of the virus to control the national or local outbreaks. Once they have done so, to deal with the complex challenge of reopening,

it is important to be guided by the following parameters: ensure the safety of all, plan for inclusive reopening, listen to the voices of all concerned, and coordinate with key actors, including the health community.

Protect education financing and coordinate for impact: The pandemic has pushed the world into the deepest global recession in living memory which will have lasting effects on economies and public finances. National authorities and the international community need to protect the education financing through the following avenues: strengthen domestic revenue mobilization, preserve the share of expenditure for education as a top priority and address inefficiencies in education spending, strengthen international coordination to address the debt crisis, and protect official development assistance for education.

Build strong education systems for equitable and sustainable development:

Strengthening the resilience of the education systems enables countries to respond to the immediate challenges of safely reopening of the educational institutions and positioning them to better cope with future crises. In this regard, the governments could consider the followings: focus on equity and inclusion, reinforce capacities for risk management at all levels of the system, ensure strong leadership and coordination, and enhance consultation and communication mechanisms.

Accelerate change in teaching and learning: The massive efforts made in a short time to respond to the shocks to education systems remind us that the changes are possible. We should seize the opportunity to find new ways to address the learning crisis and bring about a set of solutions previously considered difficult or impossible to implement. The following entry points could be to the fore of our efforts: focus on addressing learning losses and preventing dropouts particularly of marginalized groups, offer skills for the employability programmes, support the teaching profession and teachers' readiness, expand the definition of the right to education to include connectivity, remove barriers to connectivity, strengthen data and monitoring of learning, and strengthen the articulation and flexibility across levels and types of education and training.

Internal Program Review

Quality assurance is a continuous process, not a onetime event or an event at specific intervals. Thereby, the Faculty decided to conduct internal program review for each year. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the Faculty has prepared guidelines for the internal program review. Accordingly, the four departments reviewed their respective programmes. The reviews were conducted by committees appointed by the Faculty Board and these committees consisted with internal and external experts on quality. Department of Accountancy on 14 th August 2020, Department of Banking and Finance on 1 st of February 2021, Department of Business Management on 18 th December 2020 and Department of Insurance and Valuation on 28 th December 2020. Through the Internal review it was expected to ensure the compliance of the study programmes with minimum standards prescribed in respect of eight (8) quality criteria in the Programme Review.

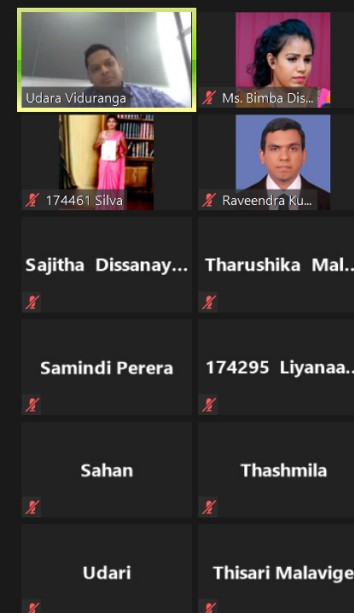
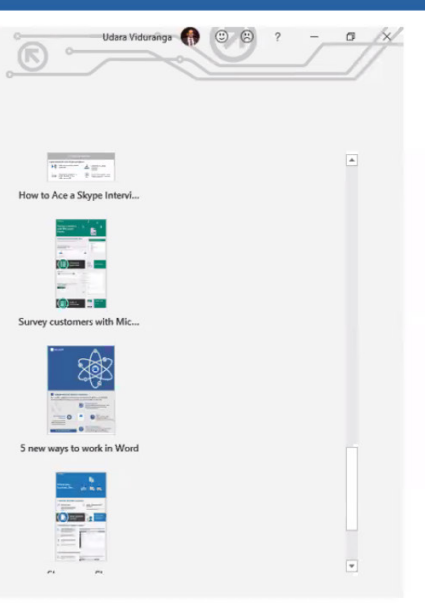

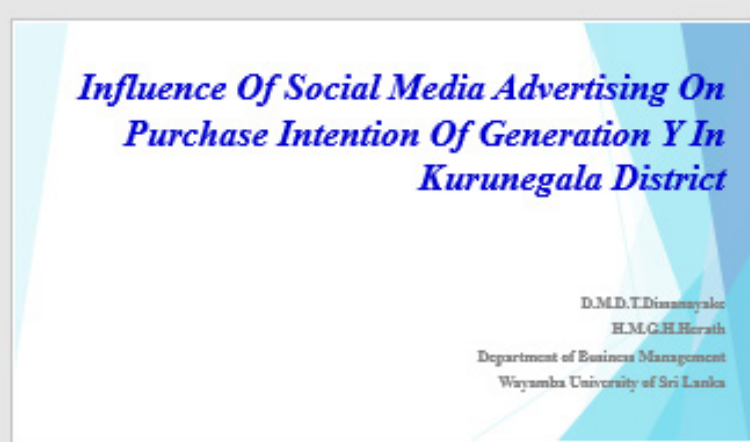
The undergraduates of the Department of Business Management (DBM) published their research outcomes at the 2nd Management Undergraduates' Research Session (MURS) – 2020

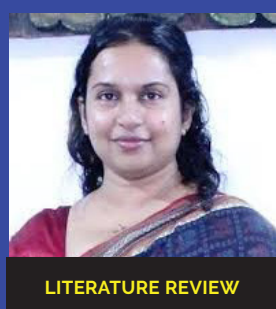
Webinar Series, organized by the Research Circle of the Department of Banking & Finance

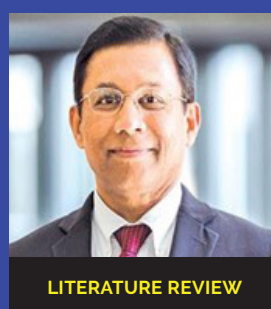

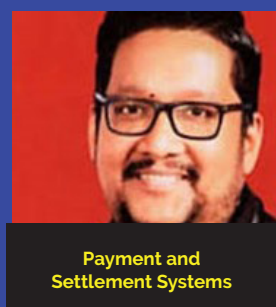

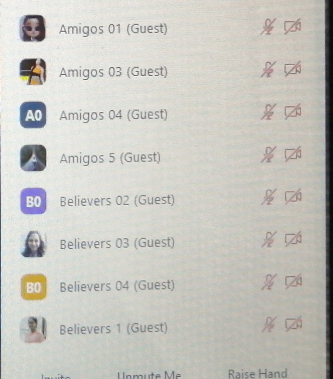
